Key Responsibilities

1. In partnership with volunteers, develop, promote, and enhance existing ministries with children & youth
2. Recruit, develop, and train volunteers for ministries. Ensure that volunteers adhere to the church's policies regarding safety and security
3. In partnership with volunteers select children and youth curriculum, midweek and summer programming materials
4. Coordinate health and wellness programs throughout the church, examples are special speakers, support groups, exercise, and heart health
5. Coordinate special fellowship events such as Easter Egg Hunt & trunk-or-treat
6. Ensure communication with congregation about children and youth & health and wellness
7. Identify and implement strategies to attract and engage children and youth in the surrounding neighborhoods
