3. Oversee and collaborate with nursery volunteers to create a safe environment, with a faith-based curriculum, for Sunday morning nursery
4. In partnership with volunteers and staff, select children and youth curriculum, including midweek and summer programming materials
5. Provide clear, timely communication with congregation and families regarding children and youth ministries
6. Ensure all volunteers adhere to the church's policies regarding safety and security for children and youth
7. Coordinate special community events (such as Easter egg hunt & trunk-or-treat) that welcome and engage families
8. Develop and implement outreach strategies to attract and connect with children and youth in the surrounding community
